With the NHL trade deadline Monday, expect some key players to move within the next 24 hours, and with that means a few shifts in power. The Blue Jackets, now with Ryan Dzingel and Matt Duchene, look like playoff locks, and if they win the division it wouldn't be all that surprising.

That also means the Senators have a lot of minutes to go around, and younger players may take priority. Here's a pre-trade deadline rundown of which teams will have to reorganize.

Ottawa Senators

If we're operating under the assumption that Mark Stone is traded, the Sens basically have to replace an entire first line from within the organization. They won't be able to replace the quality, but someone has to take the minutes. On the power play, that will be Brady Tkachuk, Chris Tierney, Colin White and Mikkel Boedker, with rookies Logan Brown, Drake Batherson and maybe Filip Chlapik also coming into the picture. In Saturday's loss to the Jackets, all except Chlapik played more than three minutes in four power plays.

Excluding Stone, Tierney is now the team's highest-scoring forward with just six goals, having never led his team in scoring since minor midgets. That means Tkachuk presents the most upside, followed by White, a first-round pick who is now pencilled in as their No. 1 center next season.

However, the most intriguing piece is Batherson, a possible gem the Sens unearthed in the fourth round who has scored 49 points in 41 games in the AHL (also as a rookie) and also looks like a bona fide top-line scorer. The question is how much ice time Guy Boucher is willing to give him.






The Toronto Raptors (38-22) defeated the Philadelphia 76ers (13-47) 114-103 on Monday at the Wells Fargo Center in Philadelphia.

Both teams shot surprisingly well in this one, with the Raptors finishing at 51 percent from the field and 41 percent from the three-point line, while the floor and 40 percent from deep. Raptors Looking To Make Most Of Home Court Advantage

The Toronto Raptors play host to the Golden State Warriors in Game 2 of the NBA Finals, at Scotiabank Arena on Sunday evening. The Raptors made a statement with a convincing 118-109 win in Game 1 in Toronto. Pascal Siakam led the way for Toronto with a historic showing in his first NBA Finals appearance. Siakam tallied 32 points, eight rebounds, five assists, two blocks and a steal, while shooting an incredible 14-of-17 from the field, including 2-of-3 from deep. Kawhi Leonard and Marc Gasol each topped 20 points, while Fred VanVleet provided a boost off the bench with 15 points in 33 minutes. The Raptors are now 3-0 against the Warriors in their meetings this season. However, they are nowhere near finished, as the seasoned Warriors team cannot be counted out. The Raptors will need to bring their defense again like they did in Game 1, where they held the Warriors to 44 percent shooting in Game 1, and forced 16 turnovers. Meanwhile, the Warriors remain without Kevin Durant (calf), who is ruled out for Game 2 and not expected back possibly until Game 4 at least. DeMarcus Cousins did not look too comfortable in Game 1, as he played just eight minutes off the bench, in what was his first game back in action since tearing his quad in the first round. Stephen Curry tallied 34 points, five rebounds and five assists, in Game 1, while Klay Thompson added 21 points, and Draymond Green finished with a 10-10-10 triple-double. However, the Warriors will need more in Game 2, as guys like Andre Iguoldala and Shaun Livingston will need to step up with their veteran presence, while youngsters like Jordan Bell and Quinn Cook need to give solid minutes to aid their starters. The Warriors gave up 24 fastbreak points in Game 1 and can make improve their chances in Game 2 by limiting those-esy buckets.

Joel Embiid

25-Year-Old Center Philadelphia 76ers NBA

2018 Fantasy Outlook

After playing in just 31 outings as a rookie, Embiid was able to more than double his amount of games played in 2017-18, taking the court for 63 contests. The 76ers also felt more and more comfortable getting their big man extended run and after being brought along slowly early on in the season, Embiid ended the year averaging 30.3 minutes. He turned that into his first full season of averaging a double-double, finishing with 22.9 points, 11.0 rebounds, 3.2 assists and 1.8 blocks. Those numbers placed him 15th in the league in scoring, ninth in rebounds and sixth in blocks, while it also earned him his first selection as an NBA All-Star. In addition, Embiid was a capable floor stretcher, knocking down 1.0 three-pointer at a 30.8 percent clip. That wasn't the most efficient number, but still forced defenses to extend to the perimeter and not sag in the lane. Looking forward to the upcoming campaign, Embiid should be in line for a similar role and could actually see another slight uptick in his workload now that he's further away from the foot injuries that plagued him previously. Obviously, one of Embiid's biggest downfalls is his health, so the risk of him missing double-digit games is always on the table. However, his elite production in multiple categories, as well as the fact that Embiid finished second in the league in usage percentage behind James Harden last year, should bring him into consideration to be a top-5 center off the board. He would benefit with increased efficiency from the three-point line, as well as the charity stripe, but with another offseason to hone in on his shot, Embiid will be an elite Fantasy asset.

28-Year-Old First Baseman New York Yankee

2019 Fantasy Outlook


The Yankees needed an insurance policy behind Greg Bird at first base. Many were underwhelmed when that player turned out to be Voit. Funny how things work out. He hit two homers in a game Aug. 26 and the Yankees decided to give him a longer look at first. Voit hit .323/.402/.707 in his final 28 games, relegating Bird to the bench and off the roster entirely for the Wild Card Game. He had an OPS over 1,000 against RHP and LHP. Voit had flashed some pop, but as a 22nd round pick in 2013 and a R/R first baseman, he was never considered much of a prospect. Given that lack of pedigree and his 26.7 K%, it's understandable to be skeptical of a player whose first big-league success came at age 27. However, everything in his batted-ball profile (47.0 Hard%, 35.0 GB%, 41.0 Pull%) suggests he deserved all the success he had last season. That does not mean he will replicate it, but there are not glaring red flags that suggest significant regression is coming.







