Listed as top kickoff returner

UPDATE 05-30-2019

Michel is the only kick returner listed on the Pats' current depth chart, Andrew Callahan of Masslive.com reports. The running back logged four kickoff return attempts for 77 yards last season.

ANALYSIS: It remains to be seen how much return work the Patriots' lead back will do this coming season, but there's a void to fill in that area following the departure of Cordarrelle Patterson, who averaged 28.8 yards on 23 kickoff returns in 2018. Given Michel's importance to the team's ground attack, it wouldn't surprise us to see another primary kickoff returner identified in the coming months, however. As a rookie last year, Michel totaled 209 carries for 931 yards and six TDs in 13 regular-season games, while adding seven catches for 50 yards. He's now set to reprise his role as the team's preferred early-down option.

TOM BRADY

Skips voluntary OTAs

UPDATE 5-23-2019

As expected, Brady wasn't in attendance during Thursday's OTAs, the Boston Herald reports.

ANALYSIS: The Patriots' current workouts are voluntary, so this nugget isn't really concerning. In his absence, added QB reps are available for Brian Hoyer, Danny Etling and rookie Jarrett Stidham. Once Brady does take the field with his teammates, he won't have tight end Rob Gronkowski, who retired this offseason, to throw to. Brady's top target last year, Julian Edelman, just signed a contract extension and the team welcomes first-rounder N'Keal Harry to the pass-catching fold. Beyond that, the team's wideout depth chart is fluid, with the likes of Dontrelle Inman, Phillip Dorsett, Maurice Harris, Braxton Berrios and Demaryius Thomas (Achilles') -- when healthy -- looking to secure roles in the Patriots offense.

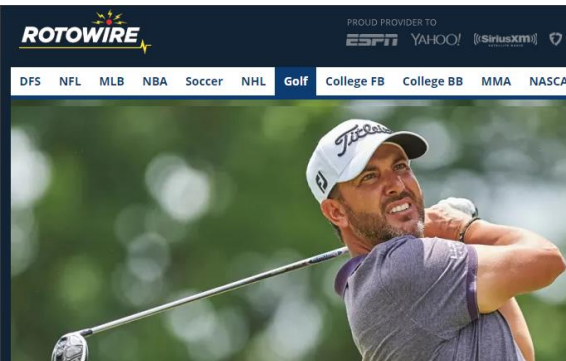

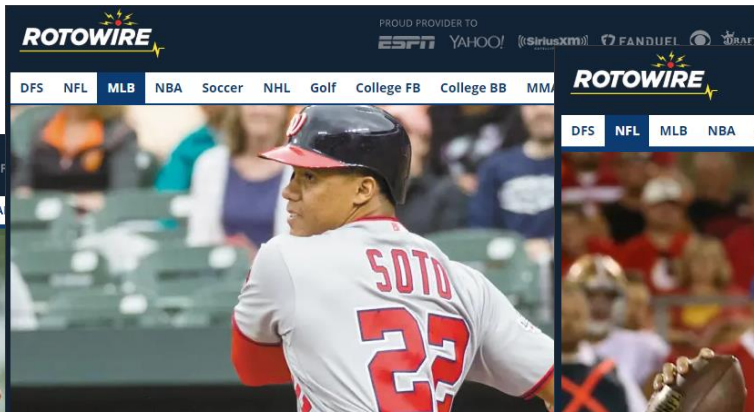

Less than an hour drive from the heart of Toronto, Drake and the rest of an avid Raptors fan will have a chance to relax along the historic grounds of Hamilton Golf & CC throughout the weekend while their NBA squad faces a dynasty in the Bay Area. 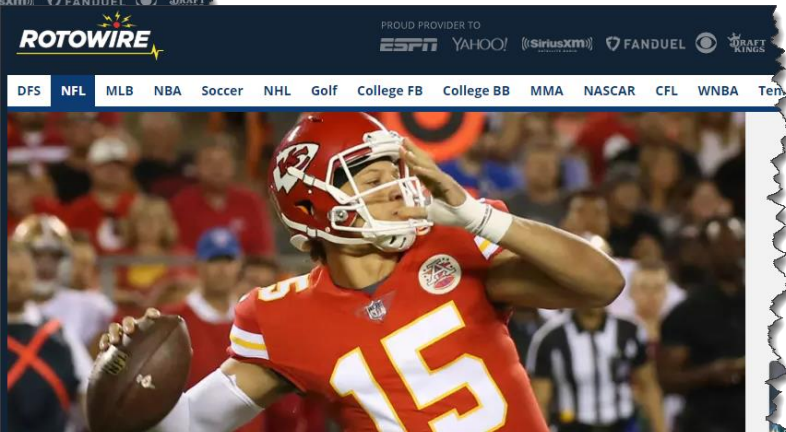
Pitching Overview

Lefties [Hyun-Jin Ryu](#) (\$11,200) and [Blake Snell](#) (\$11,000) follow. Ryu couldn't be faulted for having allowed two runs or fewer in every start to date, and just two total in his last three. He generally lacks strikeout upside and faces a D'Backs side that has only a 21.2 percent rate against lefties while ranking third with a .367 wOBA, but Ryu did fan eight in six innings against Arizona in his first start of the year. Maybe the D'Backs ownership down and he's overlooked. Snell against Detroit presents very similar value. The Rays ace has allowed two runs or fewer in four straight starts and gets an average of 26.4 percent of the time with a .158 ISO.

[Kyle Hendricks](#) (\$10,200) rounds out the five-figure pitching options, and seems like a value pick for despite recent success that has seen him post 40 or more FDP in five of his last six. At home, he still faces a Rockies offense that ranks 10th with a .331 wOBA.

[Noah Syndergaard](#) (\$9,000) has displayed an inconsistency that makes him a risky pick, but unfortunately he will have a lot of eyes on him against a woeful Giants offense. He's failed to provide 30 FDP in three straight outings, but San Fran ranks 27th with a .290 wOBA and 80 wRC+. Maybe that makes him a better cash game cap saver than a tournament upside play. [Shane Bieber](#) (\$9,500) and [Chris Paddack](#) (\$9,800) have been too good to ignore, but face sound offenses in Minnesota and Philadelphia, and are of little interest as such. [Masahiro Tanaka](#) (\$9,200) could go overlooked on this deep slate. Toronto fans 25.5 percent of the time while posting a .283 wOBA.

San Antonio's Tim Duncan Close to Passing Iverson for 20th in Career Points

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The Spurs' **Tim Duncan** needs 18 points to pass **Allen Iverson** for 20th place on the NBA's career points leaders list. Iverson, who did not officially retire until October 2013, spent most of his career with the Philadelphia 76ers and finished with 24,368 career points in 914 games. Duncan has played in 1,219 games during his career, 1,217 of which he has started.

Duncan will likely surpass Iverson within the next game or two, and the Spurs' big man has a good shot to reach 25,000 points by the end of the 2013-14 season. Duncan is 16th on the NBA's all-time rebounding list with 13,600 boards, and eighth on the all-time blocks list with 2,728 swats. He needs just five more blocks to pass Shaquille O'Neal for seventh place.

Oddly enough, Duncan has never led the NBA in blocks or points in a season, and he only led the league in rebounds once, back during the 2001-02 campaign. He'll take aim at the record books Friday in Atlanta, before heading to Miami on Sunday for a rematch of the 2012-13 NBA Finals.

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Jose Abreu Sets 1st-Half Rookie Records for Home Runs and Total Bases

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It's no secret that **Chicago White Sox** first baseman Jose Abreu has burst onto the scene, but the rate at which he's threatening first-year player records still comes as a bit of a surprise.

The Cuban rookie has already set a pair of records among first-year players in the All-Star Game era, with 29 home runs, 50 extra-base hits and 203 total bases before the break, **per MLB Stat of the Day**. The Midsummer Classic, of course, goes back to 1933, covering all but 13 years of the live-ball era.

Going back to 1933, Abreu's 29 home runs before the All-Star break rank second-best among all rookies, trailing only the 33 that Mark McGwire hit for the **Oakland Athletics** in 1987, **according to ESPN Stats & Info**.

McGwire finished that season with 49 home runs, **setting a rookie record that stands to this day**. With 29 home runs through his team's first 96 games, Abreu is on pace to match McGwire, despite spending time on the disabled list in late May and early June.

On a per-game basis, Abreu has bested McGwire, homering once every 2.83 games. "Big Mac" logged 151 contests as a rookie in '87, hitting one out every 3.08 games.

McGwire also had the advantage of some previous big-league experience, as he logged 58 plate appearances in 1986, falling well short of the threshold needed to lose rookie eligibility. Therein lies the distinction between "first-year players" and "rookies," as Abreu qualifies as both while McGwire was merely a rookie in 1987.

Of course, McGwire was also only 23 years old at the start of the '87 season while Abreu turned 27 in January.

The Toronto Raptors play host to the Golden State Warriors in Game 2 of the NBA Finals, at Scotiabank Arena on Sunday evening. The Raptors made a statement with a convincing 118-109 win in Game 1 in Toronto. Pascal Siakam led the way for Toronto with a historic showing in his first NBA Finals appearance. Siakam tallied 32 points, eight rebounds, five assists, two blocks and a steal, while shooting an incredible 14-of-17 from the field, including 2-of-3 from deep. Kawhi Leonard and Marc Gasol each topped 20 points, while Fred VanVleet provided a boost off the bench with 15 points in 33 minutes. The Raptors are now 3-0 against the Warriors in their meetings this season. However, they are nowhere near finished, as the seasoned Warriors team cannot be counted out. The Raptors will need to bring their defense again like they did in Game 1, where they held the Warriors to 44 percent shooting in Game 1, and forced 16 turnovers. Meanwhile, the Warriors remain without Kevin Durant (calf), who is ruled out for Game 2 and not expected back possibly until Game 4 at least. DeMarcus Cousins did not look too comfortable in Game 1, as he played just eight minutes off the bench, in what was his first game back in action since tearing his quad in the first round. Stephen Curry tallied 34 points, five rebounds and five assists, in Game 1, while Klay Thompson added 21 points, and Draymond Green finished with a 10-10-10 triple-double. However, the Warriors will need more in Game 2, as guys like Andre Iguodala and Shaun Livingston will need to step up with their veteran presence, while youngsters like Jordan Bell and Quinn Cook need to give solid minutes to aid their starters. The Warriors gave up 24 fastbreak points in Game 1 and can make improve their chances in Game 2 by limiting those easy buckets.

23-Year-Old Quarterback **Kansas City Chiefs**



2019 Fantasy Outlook

Entering last season, the question in Kansas City was less about Mahomes' NFL aptitude than whether coach Andy Reid would open the offense or play it cautious with his first-year QB. Reid went for broke, and the cannon-armed Mahomes paid off. He threw a league-high 80 passes longer than 20 yards, accounting for 13.8 percent of his attempts (most are at least 450 yards) and leading the league with 10 TD throws. Mahomes also ranked second in YPA (8.8) and average target depth (9.2). Easily the MVP, he became the first QB in NFL history to pass for 5,000-plus yards and 50 touchdowns. Losing Kareem Hunt the last five games didn't hurt that much, but it could be a different story if Tyreek Hill - who is banned indefinitely from all team activities because of field issues - doesn't return. Hill was Mahomes' favorite target last season, catching a league-high eight passes for 101 yards. Next up is the oft-injured Sammy Watkins and rookie round pick Mecole Hardman. Both have questions, but Hardman is fast enough (4.33 40 for Hardman) to stretch the field. Uncoverable Travis Kelce is a constant, and the backfield has Damien Williams, who shined after Hunt exited, and in addition Carlos Hyde. Regression is inevitable - Mahomes likely to outpace the No. 2 QB by 4.5 fantasy points per game - but in Reid's offense it shouldn't be crippling, even with the loss of Hill. Joel Embiid

25-Year-Old Center **Philadelphia 76ers** NBA

After playing in just 31 outings as a rookie, Embiid was able to more than double his amount of games played in 2017-18, taking the court for 63 contests. The 76ers also felt more and more comfortable getting their big man extended run and after being brought along slowly early on in the season, Embiid ended the year averaging 30.3 minutes. He turned that into his first full season of averaging a double-double, finishing with 22.9 points, 11.0 rebounds, 3.2 assists and 1.8 blocks. Those numbers placed him 15th in the league in scoring, ninth in rebounds and sixth in blocks, while it also earned him his first selection as an NBA All-Star. In addition, Embiid was a capable floor stretcher, knocking down 1.0 three-pointer at a 30.8 percent clip. That wasn't the most efficient number, but still forced defenses to extend to the perimeter and not sag in the lane. Looking forward to the upcoming campaign, Embiid should be in line for a similar role and could actually see another slight uptick in his workload now that he's further away from the foot injuries that plagued him previously. Obviously, one of Embiid's biggest downfalls is his health, so the risk of him missing double-digit games is always on the table. However, his elite production in multiple categories, as well as the fact that Embiid finished second in the league in usage percentage behind James Harden last year, should bring him into consideration to be a top-5 center off the board. He would benefit with increased efficiency from the three-point line, as well as the charity stripe, but with another offseason to hone in on his shot, Embiid will be an elite Fantasy asset.



Luke Voit

28-Year-Old First Baseman **New York Yankees**



2019 Fantasy Outlook

The Yankees needed an insurance policy behind Greg Bird at first base. Many were underwhelmed when that player turned out to be Voit. Funny how things work out. He hit two homers in a game Aug. 26 and the Yankees decided to give him a longer look at first. Voit hit .323/.402/.707 in his final 28 games, relegating Bird to the bench and off the roster entirely for the Wild Card Game. He had an OPS over 1.000 against RHP and LHP. Voit had flashed some pop, but as a 22nd round pick in 2013 and a R/R first baseman, he was never considered much of a prospect. Given that lack of pedigree and his 26.7 K%, it's understandable to be skeptical of a player whose first big-league success came at age 27. However, everything in his batted-ball profile (47.0 Hard%, 35.0 GB%, 41.0 Pull%) suggests he deserved all the success he had last season. That does not mean he will replicate it, but there are not glaring red flags that suggest significant regression is coming.

(5/15) Bradley and Hirano each saved three games for the Diamondbacks last season, but the team somewhat surprisingly named Holland the closer four days before Opening Day.

Holland's tenure with St. Louis last season was an unmitigated disaster, but he was quietly decent after joining Washington. Walks remained an issue with the Nats (12.5 BB%), but Holland rediscovered his strikeout punch down the stretch (31.3%) and of course has the "proven closer" track record with 189 career saves. Early-season returns have been fantastic with a 1.80 ERA, 1.07 WHIP and 20.9 K:BB with eight successful save conversions in nine chances. The walk rate remains high and the .200 BABIP -- by far the lowest of his career -- suggest Holland's early results may not be sustainable.

Bradley was named the favorite early in the offseason before losing out to Holland. He was expected to be the team's best reliever but has struggled thus far in 2019 with a 4.91 ERA and 1.91 WHIP, and is allowing hard contact at the highest rate of his career (41.1%).

Hirano proved effective in his first season stateside, relying heavily on his split-finger pitch (46.3%) to induce groundballs, and is throwing that pitch even more this season. He's 34 and doesn't have the stuff of a traditional closer, with a fastball that averages just 91 mph. The veteran righty has a 2.54 FIP and 4.1 K:BB to begin 2019, but has seen into some bad luck with a 42% BABIP.
